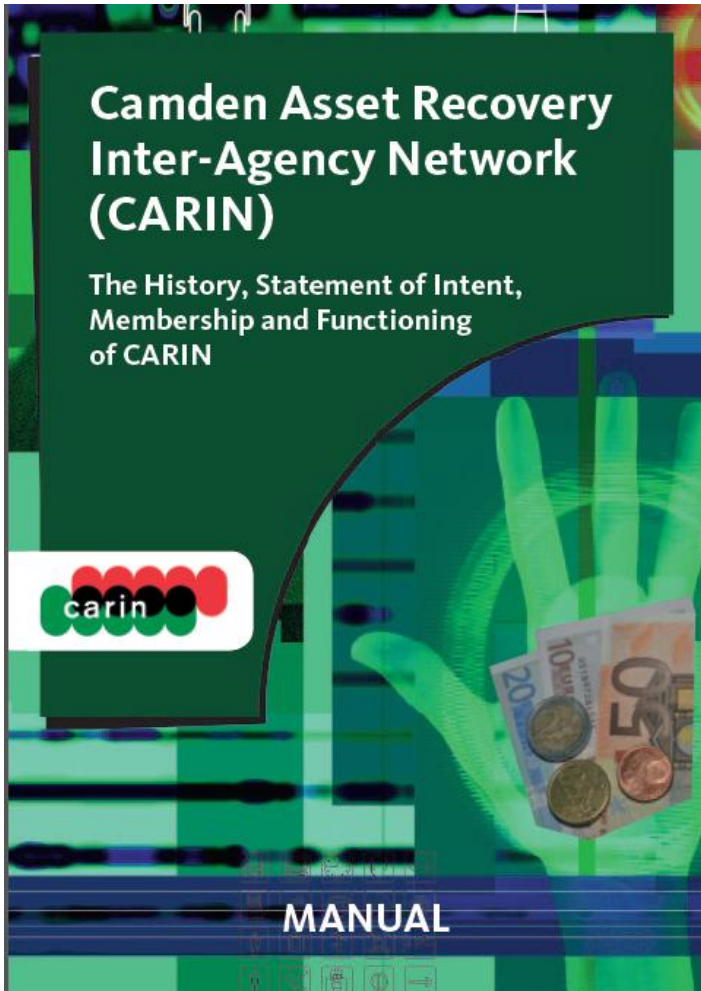


# CAMDEN ASSET RECOVERY INTER-AGENCY NETWORK (CARIN) MANUAL
