

## REPORT A CRIME

If you have information about a crime that either is being planned or has already been committed, or if you are the victim of a crime, you need to **contact your local or national police**. The authorities will contact Europol if required. Europol can deal only with information provided by the appropriate law enforcement agencies, not members of the public.

Here's how you can alert police to three types of crime in your **country**:

### REPORT CYBERCRIME ONLINE

If you have fallen victim to cybercrime, find the reporting website of your country.

If you have identified illegal content on the Internet, find the reporting website of your country.
