<sup>1</sup> Article 2(1) of the MB rules for the prevention and management of conflicts of interest in respect of its members defines a conflict of interest as an actual or potential incompatibility between the duties of a MB representative and personal interests which could impair, directly or indirectly, professional independence in the performance of the duties for the Management Board. Personal interests may, in particular, include a private or a family relationship, professional affiliations (including additional employment, appointments or former as well as envisaged employments), or influence through a third party.
