

## CCTV Privacy Statement

The controller of this processing operation is the Europol Security Department.

The purpose of the processing operation is to protect Europol against unauthorized physical access to its premises and in particular to its IT infrastructure and sensitive data. CCTV also allows the Security personnel to reconstruct situations in order to obtain relevant information regarding possible threats or incidents related to safety and security. The recorded material can be used for further analysis, investigations or evaluations, especially in the framework of Administrative Inquiries.

The recipients of the data are Europol's Security Department Management, uniformed security officers, security engineers as well as other Europol staff in the framework of an Administrative Inquiry, as stipulated in the "Management Board Decision laying down General implementing provisions on the conduct of administrative inquiries and disciplinary procedures" of 30 July 2010 and the "Director's Decision Laying down implementing provisions on the conduct of administrative inquiries and disciplinary procedures carried out pursuant to the Europol Staff Regulations" of 2 September 2010.

The European Data Protection Supervisor and the Unit of the Data Protection Officer shall have access to all data for the fulfilment of their tasks at any time.

The legal basis of the processing operation is Article 32 & 67 Europol Regulation, Article 5b of [Regulation \(EC\) No 45/2001](#) of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2000 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data by the institutions and bodies of the Community and on the free movement of such data and Europol Security Rules.

The images of cameras are recorded continuously and stored for at least 7 days with 12 images per second. After a maximum period of 14 days the images are automatically deleted from the system. Recordings of cameras placed in the parking of the World Forum (Churchillplein 10) are retained for maximum 72 hours.

Every data subject has the right to access and rectification of his/her personal data and the right of recourse at any time to the Europol Data Protection Officer (DPO - PO Box 90850, 2509LW The Hague - NL) and the [European Data Protection Supervisor](#).
