Previous positions (summary)	<p>After a public law degree at the University of Aix en Provence, he completed his military service as a reserve officer in the Air force. In 1995, he attended the superior national police school. He began his career as Superintendent in the outskirts of Paris before working in different departments in the judicial police in Paris: the fight against illegal immigration, homicide, terrorism, financial crime and organized crime. In particular, between 2004 and 2007, he was the deputy chief of the child protection unit in Paris that combats against sexual abuse, kidnappings, child sexual exploitation on and off line.</p> <p>In 2009, he became the advisor to the director general of the national police for judicial concerns, then, continued between 2013 and 2018 as head of the communication service of the national police. He specialized in crises communication during the attacks that affected France throughout this period.</p> <p>Since January the first 2019, he has been in charge of the judicial police whose 6000 personnel are engaged in the fight against organized crimes, terrorism and specialized forms of delinquency.</p>
