She has 26 years policing experience in a range of operational roles in Ireland, including the National Bureau of Criminal Investigation, the Criminal Assets Bureau which takes a multi-agency approach to seizing assets the proceeds of criminal activity, and prior to her recent promotion was in charge of An Garda Síochána’s National Criminal Intelligence Unit (NCIU). NCIU’s main role is to gather, analyse and disseminate high grade intelligence in relation to major criminals and organised crime and support national and international operations against organised crime.</p> <p>She is currently the head of the EUROPOL National Unit in Ireland and Head of the INTERPOL National Central Bureau for Ireland She has represented an Garda Síochána on a number of national and international working groups relating to the exchange of information.</p>
