Previous positions (summary)	<p>After holding position as Deputy Commissioner since 2013 for the newly formed national police, her current responsibilities include coordination of the approach to combatting organised national and international crimes and terrorism; support and coordination of large-scale operations; mounted police, sniffer dogs, forensic expertise, and VIP protection.</p> <p>As head of Operations Directorate in 2011, Van den Berg, was presented with the added responsibility of the highly demanding post of Personnel Management during the merging of 26 units into one central police force – a mammoth reorganisation, unprecedented in the Dutch public system. An unenviable position and a sharp learning curve for Van den Berg, which resulted in a laudable testimonial to her organisational, negotiating, and leadership skills; and to her uncompromising perseverance when faced with a challenge of infinite complexities. Equally noteworthy were her endeavours in the successful establishment of a collective labour agreement with the trade unions who initially opposed the reorganisation.</p>

Additional information	<p>Following completion of her studies at the Netherlands Police Academy in 1986, she was assigned Senior Police Official for the city of Utrecht. During her 30-year career holding a variety of leadership positions within the Netherlands Police ranging from law enforcement to investigation duties, she has gained extensive political administrative experience, and is well versed in large-scale operations.</p>
	<p>Next to Alternate member of the Europol Management Board, Ms Van den Berg is Chair of the Interpol European Committee. Internationally, she has accumulated work experience in China, Colombia and Italy. Early in her career she was Head of Central Football Vandalism Information, a police component focused on expertise an information exchange on football violence and hooliganism at national and international level.</p>
